HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

- ◆ Semi-annual events held at City Corporation Yard usually in April / November.
- ◆ In 2011, collected over 100,000 lbs of hazardous waste and over 23,000 lbs of electronic waste (e-waste).

HOUSEHOLD BATTERY RECYCLING PROGRAM



- ◆ Fact: Did you know it is actually illegal to throw household batteries in the trash?
- ◆ In 2011, collected over 2,500 lbs of household batteries.
- ◆ 4 collection sites:
 - ◆ Corona City Hall—400 S. Vicentia Ave.
 - ◆ Corporation Yard—735 Corporation Yard Way
 - ◆ Corona Public Library—650 S, Main St.
 - ◆ Senior Center—921 S. Belle Ave.

USED MOTOR OIL

- ◆ Drop off: collected at the City's semi-annual HHW events.
- ◆ Drop off: collected at certified collection centers throughout Corona.

BOTTLES AND CANS



- ◆ Place in your curbside recycling container (gray lid).
- ◆ Drop off: collected at certified collection centers throughout Corona.

ELECTRONIC WASTE (E-WASTE)



- ◆ E-waste includes: computers, stereo systems, TVs, microwaves, cell phones and other electronic devices.
- ◆ Drop off: collected at the City's semi-annual HHW events.

XERISCAPING/XEROGARDENING

- ◆ Refers to landscaping and gardening in ways that reduce or supplemental water from irrigation sources.

CURBSIDE COLLECTION



- ◆ Three (3) cart collection —Refuse (black), Recycling (gray), and Green Waste (green).
- ◆ Three (3) free bulky item collection request per resident per year.
 - ◆ Furniture, mattresses, old appliances;
 - ◆ Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners may be accepted with a certified CFC/Freon removal certificate;
 - ◆ Electronic waste (e-waste);
 - ◆ Used motor oil.
