TEMESCAL WASH CLEAN-UP EVENT

On Saturday, October 17, as part of California Coastal Clean-up Day 2009, the City of Corona organized the Temescal Wash Clean-Up Event located on Auburndale Road just north of West Rincon. The event was co-sponsored by the City of Corona, Pizza Hut, Lowe's, the Boys Scouts of America and the Corona Department of Water & Power.

Over one hundred volunteers from various local Boy Scout troops, schools, and Corona residents took part in the successful event. Close to twenty-three tons of trash and debris were collected by the volunteers and City crews comprised of the Public Works Department and the Department of Water & Power.
